The Langlois Volunteer Fire Department Association presents a visit with Santa and Mrs. Claus, cookies, photos, elves, and a canned food drive.



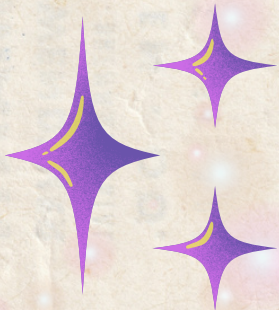

Langlois cellist Dace Sultanov will perform.



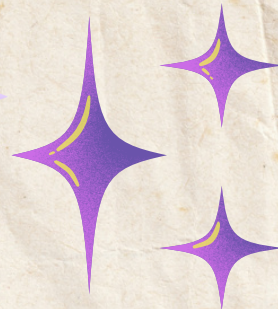
